

Photo Slideshow Builder is a simple, lightning-fast and powerful desktop utility program that lets you turn your photos into a dynamic sound-supported presentation, In just a few minutes you can make a professional-grade slideshow (picture presentation) for sending it out to all of your friends and family. You can make MPEG, WMV, AVI video files, standalone executable files and screensavers and then burn them on CD or DVD



Creating a slideshow from your digital photos has never been easier. Photo Slideshow Builder brings your pictures, images and video to life and lets you share your favorite memories with family and friends in an interesting and portable way.

Attention: If your DVD player does not support MPEG2 nor MPEG4 files, you might need an additional software for authoring DVD which will use MPEG2 files created by this program.

# Using Photo Slideshow Builder

Photo Slideshow Builder can be started either by launching the application via a desktop shortcut, or directly from within Windows/Windows Explorer.




When you start the program, you will be presented with the primary screen from which all actions are taken.

# **Adding Photo Source**

Clicking the **Add Image** icon or selecting **File** then choosing **Add Image** will open the standard file browse and select window. From that window you can navigate to the folder and find the images you want to add to the list (**Image Thumbnail**) to be filled from.

Alternatively, if you are using Windows Explorer to locate image files, you have the convenience of being able to 'drag and drop' image files into the **Image Thumbnail** list.

Photo Slideshow Builder even allows you to select all files in a particular directory/folder by using the **Add a**<u>Directory</u> option from the <u>File</u> menu! Add a directory <u>Image Thumbnail</u>

supports sub-folders.

Each added image is displayed in the Photo Slideshow Builder left window: **Image Thumbnail**, as seen in the example right. You can view any of the images in the window by 'clicking' them. That will display image files in right View window.






You can sort the images in **Image Thumbnail** by clicking the pop-up menu "**Sort by size**". Or you can change an image or multiple images order by 'drag and drop' image files in the **Image Thumbnail**. You also can select an or multiple images in the **Image Thumbnail** list, then click the **Move up** item to move selected image(s) to previous position from the **Action** menu; click the **Move down** item to move selected image(s) to next position from the **Action** menu. IF you want to delete selected images in the **Image Thumbnail**, you can click the **Remove** item or you can clear all images in the **Image Thumbnail** by clicking the **Clear** item from the **File** menu

#### **Define Slideshow Effect**

You can set the effect for slideshow: include: Transition (222 transitions Effect); Step, interval, loop etc...



Set the Slideshow Layout, Background and frame.




Set the Slideshow Speed and Photo Compress.

## **Load and Save to Project**

- You can save you slideshow design you created with "Save" button it will be save as project file (.xml) for later use.
- To load slideshow design you saved, click "Load" button and select saved Project

### **Build Slideshow**

Click "Build Slideshow (Exe)" button to generate all necessary Photo Slideshow to stand-alone EXE file



Click "Build (SCR)" button Build SlideShow (SCR) to generate all necessary Photo Slideshow to SCR files (instead of EXE), and use your presentations as a standard Windows screen savers.

Click "Build to Video" button to generate all necessary Photo Slideshow to Video, AVI, MEPG, WMV video file.






Click "Brun to CD" button (stand-alone EXE) to CD.
